FOR YOUR INFORMATION...

- 1. **CONCESSIONS** are on sale in the lobby before the show and at intermission. Please, no food or drinks in the theatre.
- 2. **SEATING.** As a courtesy to the other patrons and the performers, latecomers will be admitted at the discretion of the house manager.

FOR UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA STUDENTS

As part of the 2006-2007 student activities fee, each full-time student receives a \$60 credit per year for admission to select Departments of Drama and Music events. A student receives an additional \$15 credit for admission to Virginia Film Festival screenings.

How Can ARTS\$ Be Spent? The credit is on all full-time student IDs. You may call in your ID number and purchase tickets over the phone or come to the box offices at the Departments of Drama and Music. ARTS\$ may be used to purchase single tickets or series tickets and may be spent alone or in combination with actual currency.

What Events Do ARTS\$ Cover? In the Department of Drama all major productions this year may be purchased with ARTS\$, as well as any film screenings at the Virginia Film Festival.
